("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

Nature of Survey First Entry.

It is submitted the Gibraltar Surveyor be requested by cable to forward his report as soon as possible on completion of survey.

It is further submitted before this case receives the consideration of the Committee, the <sup>Bilbao</sup> Surveyors should be requested to state:-

1. Whether the seams of shell plating have been treble riveted at the one-fourth length from each end as required by Table 21 of the Rules.
2. Whether the scantlings of the W.T. bulkheads are as approved, and whether 9 or 10 W.T. bulkheads extend to the upper deck, as this is not clear from the Report.
3. The length and capacity of the F.W. tank between tunnels, and whether same has been tested as required.
4. Whether a notation of "pt.cem" or "Cem" should be made in this case.
