
With reference to the T.S.S. "ALFONSO XIII"
Nº1 ship of the Sociedad Española de Construccion Naval
Bilbao, which has been under my inspection for nearly seven
years it is now proposed that the vessel will proceed to Ferrol
for drydocking, as there is no dock at Bilbao which will take her.

The builders hope that she may sail about the
middle of July and after docking will run her official trials
off Ferrol.

I am not at all sure that all the work will be
completed before she leaves Bilbao, such as W.T. doors, pumps,
etc., and I would suggest that it might avoid confusion if I
went round with the vessel to Ferrol and saw her finished, so
that I could be in a position to report her as completed, that
is of course if the work of this port permits it.

I may explain that I am proposing this arrangement
as Ferrol is in the Cadiz district for hull survey. Mr. Miller
will of course also attend for the machinery trials.

I should be pleased to learn whether my suggestion
