Turbine.

FOUND.

Nozzles fractured & bent.
Impulse blades in wheel and casing fractured & bent.

RECOMMENDED.

Nozzle plate to be renewed.

To be renewed.

The above recommendations were made so as to put the turbine in as good and efficient condition as before the accident.

The estimated cost of repairs is 13,000 pesetas (Thirteen thousand pesetas.)
