

FREEBOARD REPORT on the

Habana

It is submitted the Freeboards given on the accompanying form, being those <sup>calculated on assumed draught of 30'-0"</sup> required by the Tables, merit approval, the same to be marked on the vessel's sides, inserted in the certificate of classification, and recorded in the Register Book, subject to

1. the flush cargo scuttles on the foreboard deck having efficient means of closing in accordance with Convention requirements. (The Surveyor should give particulars).
2. efficient means of closing being provided for the ventilator coamings <sup>the openings of the fore-peak air pipes.</sup> (The Surveyor should give particulars).

The load line certificate copy should be sent for issue when the conditions of assumption have been complied with and the freeboards as ascertained the correct gross tonnage inserted, particulars being forwarded to his office.
