It is submitted the Freeboards given on the accompanying form, being those ~~required by the Tables~~ ^{calculated on assumed draught of 30'-0"}, merit approval, the same to be marked on the vessel's sides, inserted in the certificate of classification, and recorded in the Register Book, subject to

1. the flush cargo scuttles on the foreboard deck having efficient means of closing in accordance with Convention requirements. (No Surveys should give particulars).
2. efficient means of closing being provided for the ventilator coamings ^{the openings of the fore-hatch air pipes}. (No Surveys should give particulars).

The last line certificate reply should be sent in issue when the conditions of assumption have been complied with ^{and} ~~and~~ the foreboards are accepted. The correct gross tonnage inserted, particulars being forwarded to his office.
