With reference to your letter of the 13th of August, we have to state that, so far as we are aware, the Owners decision whether or not to withdraw this ship from the Society's classification has not been made.

However, the ship has been submitted to Annual Load Line Survey at Jacksonville. (See Report C11(b) forwarded with Letter 5 of August 20th) and the certificates forwarded with your letter of March 22nd have been issued.

It is assumed that, should the Owners eventually come to a decision to withdraw from classification, there would be no objection to their retaining these certificates for an unclassified vessel.

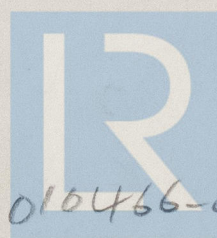
