

I acknowledge your letter of the 12th and 27th February, the contents of which have been noted, and would inform you that plans are not required unless major structural alterations have been effected since the ship was disclassed, in which case plans of such alterations would require to be submitted for approval.

For reclassification with this Society, it will be necessary for the following requirements to be complied with:-

- 1). The requirements of a Special Survey (C) to be complied with, including the drilling of the structure in such parts where signs of wastage are evident - Refer C.205 of the Rules.
- 2). Any major repairs or structural alterations which have been effected to the structure since the ship was disclassed to be specially examined in order to ascertain the character of the workmanship and confirm that the materials used are in accordance with the Rules.
- 3). Full particulars of the equipment on board, including weight, tests and condition of anchors, also lengths, diameter, tests and condition, etc, of chain cable to be furnished for consideration.
