ADMIRALTY RESCUE TUGS  
"BUSTLER CLASS"  
Spare Screw Shafts

The following information received by 'phone from:  
Eng. Capt. Williams, Whitehall.

There are seven tugs of this class, five of which are  
classed with this Society, viz:-

"BUSTLER", "SAMSONIA", "GROWLER", "HESPERIA", "RELIATOR".

Five of these seven vessels are to be chartered to  
private firms and will be allocated as follows:-

One based on Halifax, N.S. One at Singapore and  
the remaining three vessels based in Great Britain.

It has been arranged verbally with Capt. Williams that  
the two screw shafts now in Admiralty Store should be placed  
on board the tugs based on Halifax, N.S. and Singapore and that  
three additional spare shafts be manufactured and kept in store  
in U.K. dockyard for allocation to tugs sent to foreign bases.

IT IS SUBMITTED that confirmation of this arrangement  
be sent to The Director of Dockyards, Admiralty and a copy to  
C.C.R.T., Room 309, Farnham House, Leicester Square, London.

IT IS ALSO SUBMITTED the Glasgow Surveyors be informed  
accordingly.
