1st Stage.....	150 lb. per square inch.
2nd Stage.....	900 lb. per square inch.
Water Jackets.....	50 lb. per square inch.

The materials and workmanship, so far as could be seen, were sound and of good description.

The Compressor, driven direct by Motor No. 88357, made by Messrs. Laurence, Scott & Electromotors Ltd., has been tested under full load conditions for a period of four hours and found satisfactory.
