Henry Robb Ltd., Leith, and intended for their J.11827.

The pump which was driven by an electric motor was examined under working conditions and the following results were obtained :-

The pump casing was tested under hydraulic pressure to 120 lbs. per square inch; the separator was also tested under hydraulic pressure to 120 lbs. per square inch. The air pump casing was tested to 30 lbs. per square inch and all were found sound and tight.
