Ltd., attend at their works at Yoker on the 12th May, 1944 and subsequent dates for the purpose of examining and testing One 5" Upright Fire Pump, manufactured by them under Job No. D.3271, to the order of Messrs. Henry Robb, Ltd., and intended for their J.11827.

The pump, which was driven by an electric motor, was examined under working conditions and the following results were obtained:-
