The above ship, a bracketless tanker, was built by Messrs. Swan, Hunter & Wigham Richardson Ltd. in the year 1928 and almost completed her first Special Survey in August last (Newcastle Report No. 89017).

The vessel is at present laid up and the opportunity is being taken of modifying the connections at the junction of the centre line and transverse bulkheads in the main oil tanks.

A plan of the proposed alterations, together with one showing the present arrangements is accordingly submitted for the favourable consideration of the Committee.
