We are in receipt of classing letter of 14th inst. on the above named vessel, and have to state that, as concluded:-

- 1) There are seven watertight bulkheads extending to the upper deck. ✓
- 2) Ceiling is laid on the inner bottom under the hatchways. ✓
- 3) Cargo battens complying with the Rules have been fitted. ✓
- 4) The notation "Carrying oil F.P. above 150°F in deep tanks" will require to be inserted in the Register Book. ✓

Holes have not been drilled in the electrically welded butts of the bilge keels.
