Dear Sir,

The Athel Line in this Port have had two of their Barges, the "BRIMOLCO" and the "CANEMOLA" laid up for some time. They have now made arrangements to sell these two ships to Greek Owners and the Barges will be towed from Liverpool soon to Greece.

The Athel Line would like the Committee to authorise the issue of a Certificate, in each case, to enable the vessel to be towed, and are now placing the question of towage out to tender.

These are non-propelled Barges and there will be no crew on board.

I have explained that as these vessels have not been in service for some time, and have not been seen in dry dock by the Society's Surveyors for about eighteen months, it is likely that the Committee, even if they agree to the issue of the appropriate Certificate, will call for dry docking.

Will you please let me have instructions in this matter as soon as possible, as if the Committee are not prepared to meet the Owners wishes, they will have to apply to the Ministry of Transport.
