This ferry was built in the U.K. for service at Demerara and on the Rivers Berbice and Essiquibo and the class *A1 "For Service at Demerara and on the Rivers Berbice & Essiquibo" with record of 'DS 9,59' and Descriptive Notation "Ferry" recommended WHEN a report has been received of the satisfactory condition of the ferry on arrival within its service area.

The Lloyd's Agents' Surveyor at GEORGETOWN reports (12,59) ferry examined afloat and in dry dock and found in satisfactory condition.

IT IS THEREFORE SUBMITTED the ferry is now eligible to be classed *A1 "For Service on the Rivers Berbice, Essiquibo & Demerara" with Descriptive Notation "Ferry" as previously recommended and record of 'DS 11,59' assigned.
