This is to Certify that

H. K. TAYLOR and WILLIAM F. FEARNES,

undersigned Surveyors to this Society did at the request of Messrs. Ferguson (Port-Glasgow) Limited, attend at their Newark Yard, Port-Glasgow, on the 17th June, 1959, and subsequently, for the purpose of examining One Turntable, 25'-0" diameter, intended for their Yard No. 428 and suitable for handling cars, lorries, etc., on board ship up to a 17 tons load.

The table frame is built from R.S. Joists and the whole plated with stud pattern non-slip floor plates of mild steel manufactured by Messrs. Consett Iron Company Limited, Consett, County Durham, under the trade name of "Super-Grip".

The table is made up as a welded construction in three separate units and bolted together.

The table is capable of revolving 360° on self-centring thrust and radial bearing arranged so that the height can be adjusted to distribute the load between the periphery bearings which consist of a live ring of 39 bushed roller assemblies, each of which are provided with separate greasing channels and nipples, to run on a machined top race integral with the periphery I Beam, and also providing a similar lower machined race for connecting to the ship's structure.

The whole has been examined in an assembled condition prior to fitting on board ship and the workmanship found to be satisfactory.
