In reply to the enquiry contained in your Classing letter of the 12th instant, concerning the "EMPIRE LUNDY", our report No. 52553, we beg to state that the thickness of the deck plating in way of oil tanks is .30", except for one beam space at fore end of No.1 tank (frames 63 & 64) where the plating is .25" in way of the two strakes of deck, plating as shown on the approved plan of profile and decks.
