until 1,62 was approved.

On receipt of a letter dated 21.2.62 from the
Owners the Notation "Class Withdrawn" was inserted in the
Register Book 15.3.62.

A report has now been received from the Yokohama
Surveyors from which it is seen the ship was placed in dry dock,
the Special Survey commenced and various recommendations
made for repairs on account of wear and tear and conditions of
class, but on receipt of the above letter the survey was
stopped.

IT IS SUBMITTED no further ACTION need be taken
with regard to this case.
