" We have now heard from the Society's Surveyor at Balboa that the Owners realise the situation, but as the future employment of this vessel is in doubt, it is not known whether the vessel will be drydocked or not and she is at present insured against Marine Protection & Indemnity risks on the basis of the vessel being unclassified."
