I acknowledge the receipt of your cablegram of the 21st instant. The question of the overdue surveys has been discussed with the Chairman of the Classification Committee, who is disappointed to note that the Owners apparently do not appreciate the importance of fulfilling the Society's requirements for maintenance of class. If you have not already done so, it is considered you should impress upon the Owners that it is almost certain the Committee will take some action in regard to the vessel's class if the overdue Screwshaft Survey is not carried out at a very early date, bearing in mind the fact that it fell due in May 1961.

The Special Survey should also be held next month otherwise it is quite likely that the class will be withdrawn by the Committee.
