

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Messrs. Bruntons (Sudbury 1919) Ltd., Sudbury, attend at their Works on the 7th July for the purpose of making an examination of the finished sterngear made to the order of Messrs. John Harker Ltd.

The sterngear consisting of one cast iron stern tube and bush, one cast iron four bladed left handed propeller and one steel screwshaft, were examined and the materials and workmanship, so far as could be seen, were sound and of good description. Diameter of screwshaft - $5\frac{1}{2}$ ".
