With reference to the Special Survey, which becomes due at the end of September next, I shall be glad if you will ascertain from the Owners and let me know what arrangements are proposed to be made for this inspection to be carried out.

I would point out that the Main Boiler Survey became due at the end of June last, and the Owners' intentions regarding this inspection will also be appreciated.

We have been advised by the Owners that they wish to withdraw the ship from class as the machinery and boiler have been removed and cut up for scrap and the Hull is to be used as a dumb lighter. We have visited the ship and can confirm that this has been done. The Owner's letter on this subject has been sent to the Sydney Surveyors, who will forward it on to you in due course.
