In view of the foregoing ~~their~~ comments are requested and unless ~~they~~ can satisfy the Committee that the cable is in accordance with Rule requirements or equivalent thereto ~~they~~ should arrange with Owners for the cable to be either verified with certificates satisfactorily tested or replaced with cable complying with Rule requirements by completion of the Special Survey.
