Dear Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 7th instant enclosing one from Messrs, J. & P. Hutchison, Ltd., respecting the steamer "CHLORIS", the contents of which have been noted.

The case of this vessel was submitted to the General Committee at their meeting to-day, and in view of the small amount of work remaining to be done to complete the survey for classification, the Committee have decided to class the vessel 100 A1, with notations of LMC 7.23, OG, S 7.23, subject to additional strengthening being fitted at the bridge front, a pillar being fitted in the hold at the sides of Nos. 2 and 3 'tween deck hatchways, and to 30 fathoms of 1-9/16" chain cable of proper weight and test being supplied at the first opportunity.

It is understood that some damage to one sheerstrake plate etc. on the port side will be dealt with at Hamburg at the present time and that the Owners are arranged to supply the extra 30 fathoms of cable.
