With reference to the case of the Steamer "ZEITOUN", I enclose for your information copies of letters which were addressed from this Office to the Owners on the 20th November and 7th December last, and with regard thereto I have to acquaint you I am now informed by the Owners that the vessel will be drydocked at Baltimore about the 1st July, when it is intended to connect the 'H' beams to the upper deck and to carry out the Load Line Survey.

It will be noted it has been agreed to defer Item 2 (see my letter to the Owners dated 20.11.53) provided the bottom is kept under observation both externally and internally at each intermediate drydocking.

I may add that the assignment of the notation SS.Nwc.10,53 has been deferred pending completion of stiffening. A copy of this correspondence is being forwarded to our New York Office.
