Steamer "ZEITOUN".

With reference to the last paragraph of your letter of the 7th instant, I would remark that this vessel holds notations of 100A1 Carrying Petroleum in Bulk, Classification Contemplated, and Examined 8,47, BS 8,47 TS 7,47, subject to repairs being effected to shell plating etc., starboard side in way of No.5 wing tank and the equipment being brought up to Rule requirements at the first opportunity.

Pending a complete Special Survey for full classification which will be required when the vessel is four years old, i.e. 1949, a General Examination will fall due in August, 1948 and a Boiler Survey at the same time. The next screwshaft survey will not become due until July, 1950.
