the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Westinghouse Electric Corporation, attend at their Lester Plant, Essington, Pa., on the 10th of February, 1949, and subsequently, for the purpose of carrying out running tests on 2-300 K.W.-DC Turbo-generators intended for Hull No. 572, building at the Sun Shipbuilding & Dry Dock Company, Chester, Pa.

These Units were built to the order of the Maritime Commission and under the survey of the American Bureau of Shipping, all components for same having been tested by the Surveyors of that Society prior to construction.

These Units were tested without load at normal and overspeed, no vibration or noise being observed during these tests.

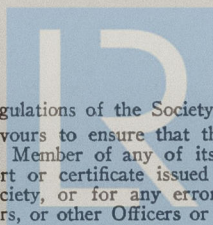
The auto stop, governor, and low oil pressure cut out, were tried out and found satisfactory.

The gear teeth were examined, and contact found in order.
