the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Owners representative attend at Messrs. van Wijnsbergen, of The Hague on the 28th October, 1963 and subsequently for the purpose of examining repairs carried out on and final testing of armature for starboard forced draught fan motor of m.s. "MOBIL FLAME".

The following repairs were made:-

1. Armature completely rewound.
2. New commutator made and fitted.
3. New front Vee ring for commutator made and fitted.
4. New commutator boss made and fitted.

The materials used and the workmanship was good.

The armature was tested for Insulation Resistance and subjected to an H.V. test of 2000 volts for one minute with satisfactory results.
