We beg to advise you that we have received a letter from The Secretary, London, informing us that arrangements have been made with you for a Surveyor from this office to join you in the Special Survey (due 4,63).

We have been informed that the Ship is programmed to dry-dock for this Survey about the end of April or the beginning of May, and in this respect will you please ensure that the Ship is fully prepared for the Survey, relevant to all shell and deck plating, holds, double bottom and other tanks and spaces, etc: being properly cleaned, or otherwise prepared for the requisite examination.

The foregoing request is being made as one of the Singapore Surveyors departs on, or about the 19th of April for long leave, thus leaving four Surveyors at the port, which in turn will leave only three Surveyors here during the Bangkok visit. Your co-operation therefore regarding this matter would be very much appreciated.

We understand that you have the necessary plans showing shell and deck plating thicknesses etc:, however your confirmation of this would also be appreciated.
