Referring to your letter dated the 3rd instant relating to Gothenburg First Entry Report No.19475 on the above ship, I beg to acquaint you that all the P.403 steel fitted in this vessel has been supplied by Messrs.Appleby Frodingham and the positions of the plates are as follows:-
Shell plating: Keel strake PK-4 to PK-12A (frs.35½-71.1/4)
Bilge strake E-5 to E-15 (frs.44½ - 69.1/4)
Sheer strake J-7 to J-16A (frs.39½-71.1/4)

Deck plating (from aft) HD-14, 20, 18, 19, 24, 27A, 27 (4 plates), 28, 29 (2 plates).

Also doublings in way of openings.

The plates referred to are on port and starboard sides.

It may be added that the deck plates have not been ordered under the same identification mark as indicated on the deck plan No.429-50/1.

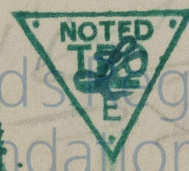
