





## Motorship "FOCA"

In reply to your letter of the 19th May 1964 we are advised by the Registro Italiano that the wear-down of the stern bush when taken at Ravenna in October 1963, was about 1.5 mm.

This information had to be obtained from the R.I.Na Surveyors at Ravenna and has only now come to hand.

Of the remaining machinery items which have been surveyed, as opposed to being generally examined under working conditions, the following are reported :-

Item 22 - Propeller	:	In order
" 23 - Sea connections	:	In order
" 24 - Overboard discharge valve	:	In order
" 25 - Fuel oil service tanks and fittings	:	In order
" 30 - Compressed air bottle (not hyd.tested)	:	In order
" 31 - Compressed Air Lines (external inspection only)	:	In order
" 32 - Windlass	:	In order
" 34 - Fire extinguishing arrangements	:	In order



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
It is considered that Items 22, 23 & 24 could be accepted but the remaining items should be re-examined and tested as necessary by a Surveyor to L.R.
