Dear Mr. Jordan,

With reference to telephone conversation last night, so far as we are aware reports on the following surveys carried out by Mr. Astrom, Helsingfors, are outstanding:-

"KIRSTA" Confirmatory survey and examination of port boiler held at Abo in September, 1948.

"SANNY" Special survey at Abo and Mariehamn in 1947/1948. Docking and annual survey at Raumo in December 1948.

"T1" Special survey at Abo in February/May, 1947.

"HELVY" Special survey at Mariehamn in January/April 1948. Raumo in December, 1948.

"AURA" Commencement reclassification survey at Helsingfors in May/Agusut, 1948.

With regard to the S.S. "KIRSTA" the reclassification held out at Oskarshamn in September/December by Mr. Astrom at Helsingborg.

It was recommended by the Surveyor at that time that 60 fathoms of port cable and 60 fathoms of starboard cable be renewed within a period of 12 months. There is no record at this office that effect has been given to this recommendation.

The ship was accepted for class on February 27, 1948, subject to confirmatory survey.

The annual classification and boiler surveys became due in December, 1948.
