M/S "T.1".

We have received your letter of the 15th March regarding the Special Survey of this vessel. We can inform you that we have submitted the vessel to Special Survey during the time 13th February to 14th May 1947, during which time this ship was in drydock at the Shipyard of the Wärtsilä-Koncernen A/B Crichton - Vulcan in Åbo while carrying out rearrangements in the accommodation and also damage repairs. Your Surveyor, Mr. Åström, was on board for the inspection, but has not written any report to you in the matter.

We have earlier insisted on getting your certificates as we here in Finland need original certificates for every Special Survey, Boiler Survey Tail Shaft Survey and Bottom Surveys. So far you have never sent us any certificates and now we here have an incident which illustrates the necessity of us getting your certificates.

We have communicated with Mr. Åström and he promised many times to soonest forward his report to you.

We are now expecting your complete Survey Certificates as soon as possible, as the vessel cannot start her traffic after the winter ice period until we get the papers.
