Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in _____

During the Annual Freeboard Survey carried out at this time the following alterations from the original assignment were noted.

1.- Access manholes to wing tanks (port and starboard) as follows:-

At Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4: Openings 500 x 350 mm. on top of local expansion trunks situated against main centre trunk, heights 1200 mm. above upper deck at Nos. 1, 2 and 3, and 1830 mm. at No. 4, steel covers 11 mm. thick, secured by 5/8" bolts spaced 2.3/4" apart.

2.- Pump Room hatch; 460 x 1460 mm. and 8'-6" above upper deck. Hinged steel cover secured by 3 toggles.

3.- Coal Hatch for Galley Bunker (Poop deck):



400 x 600 mm., Coaming 560 mm. high x 8 mm. thick.

2" thick wood cover laid fore and aft on 2" rest angles, and complete with 2 tarpaulins, battens and cleats.

4.- Hinged steel door to machinery casing (starboard side), operated both sides, 1380 x 740 mm.

Sill 560 mm. (A.)

5.- Hatch to after store now replaced by strong steel companionway with hinged wood door operated both sides, 1500 x 530 mm. Sill 450 mm. (B.)
