S.. With reference to Glasgow Report No. 46127 on the Boiler No. 839 made by Messrs. A. & W. Dalglish, I have to acquaint you that this boiler has now been satisfactorily fitted into the Steamer "PORTWAY" at Bristol, and that this vessel has to-day been classed +100A1 "Carrying Oil Fuel F.P. above 150°F, or alternatively Sand, in bulk", with notations of Lloyd's A & CP and +LMC 5,27, subject to the main condenser being renewed at a convenient opportunity.


