
I enclose herewith the First Entry Reports in respect of the motortanker "TANKLAND" - Messrs. Eriksbergs Mek. Verkstads A/B, Yard No.296, which has recently been completed at this port.

Particulars of the British tonnages are not yet available but they will be forwarded as soon as they are known. In these circumstances, for the purpose of calculating the fees, the tonnage has been assumed the same as for the previous sister ship "VARDEFJELL", the same Builder's Yard No.292.
