The anchors and cables have been tested on machines recognised by the Society but the anchors have not been tested under the supervision of the Society's Surveyors. In view of the intended service of the ship it is submitted the equipment of anchors and cables is acceptable for the Figure '1', but without the Notation "LACP".

The scantlings and arrangements, as reported, conform with the Society's Revised Rules and Regulations, and are in accordance with or equivalent to those shown on the approved plans.
