50622 "GOLDEN COMET" - This ship has today been classed +100A1, together with the appropriate notations recommended by you, and the class has been continued subject to set in and scored shell plates G.10 and 11 (port side from forward) being examined and dealt with as necessary at the next drydocking.

50556 "ROBERT W. VINKE" - This ship has today been classed +100A1 "Whaling purposes", together with the appropriate notations recommended by you. I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 19th January, the contents of which have been noted, but a reply is still awaited to the enquiry contained in the second paragraph of my classing letter of the 10th January.

50663 "ATLAS" (ex Yard No. 297) The contents of your reports have been noted, and the following notations will be recorded.
