The ROTTERDAM Surveyors report (12,60), the ship placed in dry dock and on account of damage sustained by striking quay wall, repairs effected to locally indented shell plates in way of Nos. 2 & 4 holds.

It appears the ship has been laid up and has therefore been generally examined with a view to advancing the date from which the Special Surveys date, and found satisfactory.

IT IS SUBMITTED the ship is eligible to remain as classed, with record of 'DS 12,60' assigned as recommended.
