Dear Sir,

With reference to our letter of the 3rd inst., forwarding plans for the approval of the Committee of No.21 Ship proposed to be built by Messrs. Sociedad Espanola de Construccion Naval, Bilbao, we are now informed by the Builders that the Owners desire that further accommodation should be made in this vessel and it is proposed to continue the bridge deck all fore and aft filling in the wells, the bridge sides will be plated up between the shelter and bridge deck and the superstructures generally modified.

The Builders are now preparing new plans of the superstructures and we will be pleased if you will kindly send approval of the superstructure plan, sent with our letter of 3rd., in the meantime.

The remainder of the plans forwarded will, of course, be unaffected and can be forwarded at your convenience in order to allow the builders to proceed with the ordering of the material for the bottoms etc.,

During discussion with the builders they mentioned that if any reduction in the scantlings could be approved in view of the new Rules now issued, and the vessel not yet being commenced, they will be pleased if any reductions allowed could be embodied in the plans all ready forwarded.
