The accommodation in the tween deck between frames 67 and 82 (p.s) (previously used by defence personnel) has been dispensed with, the sidelights in the shell plating in way removed and the openings fitted with welded spigot plate blanks. ✓

Tween deck bulkhead No.82 (p.s) has been removed, leaving a panel of plating suitably stiffened at the ships side, casing side and under the upper deck.

The No.2A tween deck space now extends from frames 67 to 93 (p.s). ✓
