
Dear Sir,

With reference to your classing letter of the 21st instant respecting the M.S. "MINNIPA", Cpn. Rpt. No. 7486, we beg to inform you that we have requested the Builders to let us have a copy of the profile of the vessel as built, which will be forwarded as soon as received.
