Steamer "SANROCCO"

Having regard to your letter of the 27th June and previous correspondence I have to advise you that the requisite General Examination was carried out in Drydock at Schiedam in July last, and in view of the satisfactory nature of this inspection the Committee have agreed to postponement of the Special Survey until March, 1962.

A fresh record of Docking Survey 7.61 has now been assigned, and the ship's class continued subject only to indented shell plates K.2, A.2 & 3 (port side forward) and No.1 in 4th strake below sheerstrake being specially examined and dealt with as necessary by the next Drydocking.
