Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 29th ultimo respecting the Steamer "SHEAF MEAD", the contents of which are noted.

With regard thereto I have to say that about 60% of the Classification Survey of the hull was carried out at London in June, 1947 but only £16 as General Examination fee was charged. It is therefore considered that this £16 should be credited as part of the Special Survey fee leaving £82 to be charged by you, of which half should be credited to London.
