examined the Masts, Spars, Iron Work of same, and Rigging, of the

Name of Vessel) *1/2 SHEAF HEAD, lying at the Middle Dock & Eng. 8<sup>th</sup> Ltd*the (Date of examination) *22<sup>nd</sup> September 1948*,

have to report that I found the Spars, Iron work, and Rigging of the Fore, Main, and Mizzen Masts, all in good condition, the wire work of 6 in N<sup>o</sup> Samson Post. Stay, and 6 in N<sup>o</sup> Funnel Stay, found to be fitted and in poor condition, recommend the same for renewal, the Main, and Mizzen Wood Top-masts, both struck, and topped for trial, to Ship's Staffs satisfaction.
