My dear George,

The reinforcement required in the SAM boats referred to in the Secretary's letter of the 24th May, is that given in the letter from Lawrie Edwards dated 28th January, 1944. This reinforcement has been accepted by the Society as fulfilling the Society's Rule requirements. I trust that everything is now in order.

We are already classing a number of these vessels along the lines indicated in the Secretary's letter of May, 1946, and I would suggest that the difference between our procedure and that of the British Corporation, who will, I understand, accept the vessels as they are for classification, but will, of course, require a Special Survey when it becomes due, is merely that of one or two General Examinations, depending on the age of the vessel, and one may argue that class with Lloyd's Register is surely worth this small trouble.
