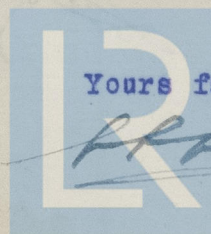
A request form 8 a, signed by the Builders, for survey with a view to classification in Lloyd's Register is enclosed herewith.
