The classes of the Steam Trawler "FRANCISCO" and the Tug "MONTORIOL" have been expunged from the Register Book, and a notation of "Sunk" made in each case.

"SANTA ANNA", "RICARDO R", "MARIA R" ex "ALHAMBRA".

The classes of the Steam Trawler "SANTA ANNA" and the Motorship "RICARDO R" have been expunged from the Register Book with a red line in each case, and the Committee have given instructions for the class of the Steamer "MARIA R" ex "ALHAMBRA" to be omitted from the forthcoming reprint of the Register Book.
