I have surveyed the above ship in accordance with the Rules for a General Examination to ascertain condition for use as a storing vessel whilst lying at anchor at Larvik.

Items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated. Ship examined whilst lying at anchor at Larvik and generally examined all holds, 'tween decks, engine space, decks, hatchways, covers, supports, tarpaulins, cleats and battening arrangements. Hold bilges cleaned and generally examined.

All the above parts found in generally good condition and the ship may in my opinion be used as a storing ship as an unclassified ship, whilst lying at anchor at Larvik for a period not exceeding 12 months.

I recommend that this ship remain as classed ~~with~~ without fresh record of dry docking
