This vessel, which is of the three island type, was built in 1919 by Messrs. J.F. Duthie & Co., Seattle, and classed with the American Bureau. She has now been acquired by the Ministry of Shipping and it is desired that the vessel be classed with Lloyd's Register.

The New York Surveyors have carried out a Condition Survey and issued a provisional certificate pending the carrying out of the requirements of a ~~2nd~~ Special Survey No.3 for classification, which will be completed at a later date. They also forward plans of Midship Section, Profile & Decks and General Arrangement so that the scantlings may be examined. This has been done and the scantlings and arrangements compared with the requirements of the Rules in force when the vessel was built, and it is found that they are equivalent thereto, and subject to the scantlings being verified (full particulars of which, including equipment, should be sent on a First Entry Report Form), the Surveyors <sup>satisfying</sup> satisfy themselves in regard to the scantlings of the bulkhead, strengthening of bottom forward <sup>and to</sup> and panting arrangements, ~~on receipt of~~ a satisfactory report on completion of the Special Survey the vessel could be recommended for the class 100A1.

If a freeboard is desired the usual particulars on Form C.11 should be forwarded.
